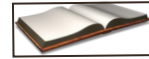
This program is suitable for adults and children. Francine will also instruct how to view eclipses safely and free solar eclipses glasses will be distributed.

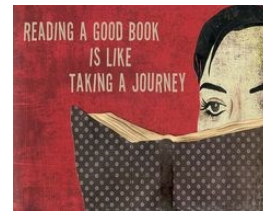
