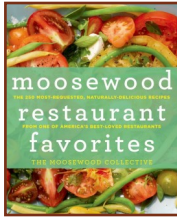

Create a precious keepsake ornament.

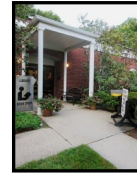
December 21, 10:30 a.m., (Ages 2-5)
