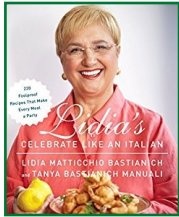

Note: Participants must be able to type their own resume.

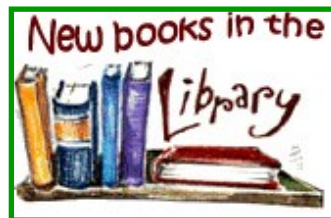
