Close to Home by Robert Dugoni
While investigating a hit-and-run death of a young boy, Seattle homicide detective, Tracy Crosswhite makes a startling discovery: the suspect is an active duty serviceman. Evidence is “lost” and it becomes more likely that this case goes a lot deeper than the military protecting one of its own. This is another thrilling addition to the Crosswhite series.

A Monster Calls
Visually spectacular emotional drama about a boy who moves in with his cold grandmother (Sigourney Weaver) after his mother becomes ill. The young boy turns to his artwork and conjures up a 40-foot-tall monster (voiced by Liam Neeson) who becomes the most unlikely ally guiding him on a journey of courage and truth. Rated: PG-13
