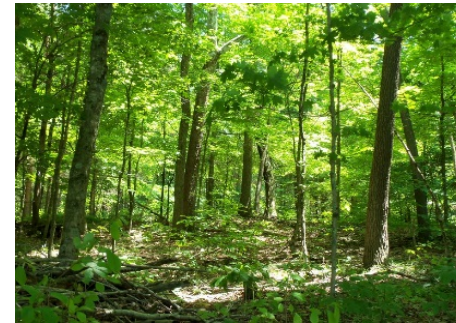
**\*We will meet at the parking lot on Putnam Pike ACROSS from the Harmony Post Office**

**Walk 6: Pulaski Park**

Wide and well-maintained trails offer a walk over a stream through a covered bridge and ending with views of a lovely pond.

**\*We will meet at the parking lot on Pine Orchard Road.**

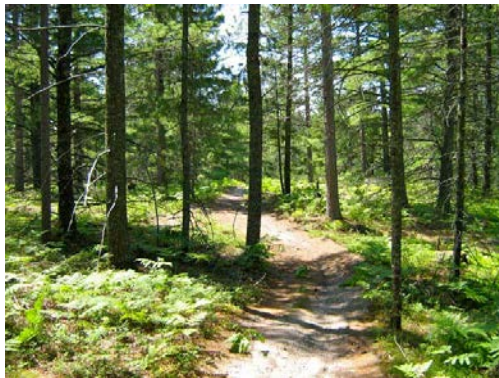
